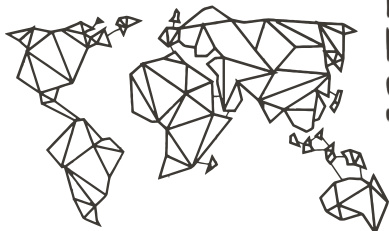

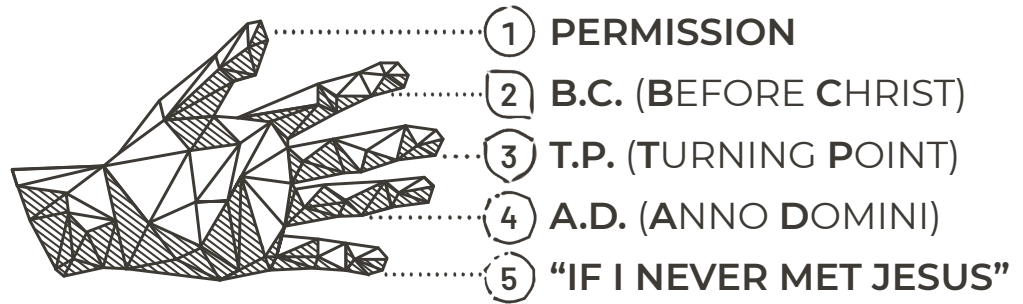

SHARE YOUR STORY!

① PERMISSION | "MAY I ASK YOU A QUESTION?"

Begin by asking permission. Start by asking:

→ **"May I ask you a question?"**

If they say, "Yes," ask:

→ **What is the best thing that has ever happened to you?**

Listen, converse with them, and show them you care. Then, when they are done, ask:

→ **May I share the best thing that has ever happened to me?**

If they say "Yes," continue with your One-Minute Witness.

Anno Domini (A.D.) is Latin for "the year of our Lord," and is used, in the context of the One-Minute Witness, to describe the period of time after placing our trust in Jesus Christ as the Lord of our lives.

TAKING IT FURTHER

Once you share your story, ask the person you are meeting with if they would be interested in knowing how Jesus could do something like this in their lives. If they say, "Yes," be prepared to go through the Gospel in more depth. (You may want to use the *Knowing God Personally* booklet², the GodTools app³, or some other tool for this.)

When you are through, ask:

→ **Are you ready to trust Jesus as your Savior and Lord today?**

If so, lead them in a short prayer, helping them verbalize their decision to the Lord.

If someone you share with puts their faith in Christ, schedule a time to meet with them in the coming week and encourage them in their new walk with God! (If they do not have a Bible, you can bring one for them at that appointment. You can also plan to meet with them regularly to work through the *One Year Discipleship* tool⁴, or the *30-Days of Growing* plan at growingwithJesus.com.)
